Application Criteria

To apply for this scholarship:

- *A parent must be a NEA-Danbury member
- *You must include an **official transcript** from your high school
- * Applications must be received by 3 p.m. April 12, 2019.
Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.
- *You must be available for a potential personal interview on either May 13 or May 20 between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. We will notify you in advance of your appointment time if you are a finalist.

Academic/School Criteria (equal value and not listed in rank order)

Your application will be judged on:

- *Academic excellence
- *School related sports, clubs or activities
- *Community service and work-related experience
- *Essay response
- *Personal Interview (if you move to the final evaluation round and the committee feels that additional candidate information is necessary)
